"COME YOU BLESSED OF MY FATHER"



(Matthew 25 vs 31-end)

".....For I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me.""Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the least of these My brethren, you did it to Me.`

Life is all about solving problems - hence, a temporary place of assignment. As far as the earth remains, their would always be a neighbour who is in dire need, hurting, hungry, naked and homeless.

In law, a neighbour is someone who is directly affected by your actions or omissions which you can reasonably forsee would likely injure him.

Biblically, he is someone you show mercy to, or have been ordained to rescue out of distress either far or near.

According to our text, the challenge of any group of persons or an individual regarded as a member of the body of Christ is Jesus' challenge. Each time any of the brethren is hurting, Jesus feels the pain and by all means looks for someone - a neighbour who could help fix the problem.

The righteous in the text saw other brethren in need, sick and desolate, they attended to them and were granted access to inherit the kingdom while those who ignored them were refused access and sentenced to hell. Why? Simply because of what they did or didn't do for Jesus respectively.

Jesus categorically told the righteous "I was sick you visited me, hungry and you fed me, naked; you covered me", they asked him "When did we do these for you?" He said to them, "Inasmuch as you did it for the least of these my brethren you did it for me."

They were just being good, they simply added good works to their faith - What a Balanced Equation !!. There's a great lesson to draw from this parable, when brethren are going through turbulent periods, Jesus' Himself is the one directly in pain. - "For we do not have an high Priest who is unable to empathise with us in our weaknesses. (Heb 4 :15 NIV). So many people today both in Church and the society at large are distressed, how much of these pains are we relieving Jesus of ?. When a child is sick, the mother feels the pain and wants relief for him, so is Jesus.

When someone smiles because they encountered us the Lord is happy and heaven applauds us ; For every rich man, there is a Lazarus to be laid at his gate for daily bread (Luke 16 : 19 - 21) and for every Church, there is an inprisoned Peter to intercede for, else he would be killed like James. (Acts 12 vs 1 - 5). Also, for every good Samaritan, there's an injured traveller to cater for (Luke 10 vs 25 - 37). For every king David, there is a crippled Mephibosheth to be shown kindness. (2 Samuel 9 : 1) ; For every Barnabas, there's a Paul to encourage. (Acts 13, 14). And lastly, for every Joseph, there is a famineshed and dying nation to preserve. Genesis 45 vs 4 - 7

Someone, somewhere, somehow, is ordained to smile through us. I am a channel to somebody, so are you. For some people, you might just need to interceed, counsel or encourage and their spirit would come alive. Men needs to see Jesus and what He represents through us, for we are an extension of His arms to the Church and the world at large. Acts 10:38 says ; 'How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with Holy Ghost and power who went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed of the devil for God was with Him.'

Everyone Jesus encountered had a better story to tell. How many people have a good story to tell simply because they met us ?. Salvation / Faith in Jesus is important so also is good works. James 2 vs 26 says faith without works is dead.

Our society today is full of the less priviledged, people for whose sake the Lord was here.

Back then in the early 20's at a particular spot, I used to see a beggar who knelt in the sun all day begging for alms. Each time I passed through that area, something pricks my heart and passion runs through my veins, I wondered what could be done to bring a change to his situation.

This passion grew more and more as I saw a lot of them sitting in the sun begging for alms. At a point I began to see beyond meeting their physical needs. I wondered aloud, "Will they go to hell because of their deformity? Is there nobody to talk to them about the love of Jesus?" Afterall God is the God of both the able and the disabled and His kingdom is meant for both.

Then one day I encountered a parable of the great supper in Luke 14 vs 12-24; A certain man invited able guests to supper but they turned down His invitation because they had careers to pursue, he therefore sent his servants to quickly enter the streets, lanes of the city and highways and bring in the poor, the maimed, the lame and the blind to supper.

That day I was convinced my earlier feelings were beyond ordinary passion but was a pointer to a vision God wants me to pursue. That was how we added BEGGARS' OUTREACH as part of our mandate at The Global Harvest Mandate as an NGO.

During these outreaches, we package food items for the less privileged, talk to them (interpreting in their language) briefly about Jesus' love and how He wants a better life for them here and in the world to come.

By God's grace, we're looking forward to having a relief home in some states where we'll house those who have responded to Jesus in faith and their vulnerable children, so they can experience and enjoy a better standard of life.

The righteous in the above parable were not given the kingdom because they were great apostles, teachers or pastors but simply because they added good works to their faith.

Jesus didn't have a pulpit to Himself all through His stay here. He moved from temple to synagogues, city to city, street to street doing good works and preaching the glad tidings to the poor.

YOUR CONDUCT IS A REFLECTION OF YOUR HEART



Proverbs 23:7 New King James Version- "For as he thinks in his heart, so is he..."

Proverbs 23:7 Amplified version- "For as he thinks in his heart, so is he [in behavior—one who manipulates]..."

Welcome to another edition on the HEART. In the last series on "Guard your heart", we were made to understand that we are a product of the thought of God's heart. Also, a man's thought determines his life so we need to filter what goes into our heart and get it sanctified and purified by the Word of God.

According to our anchor scripture above, as a man thinks in his heart that is who he is, that is, your conduct is a reflection of your heart. The thought of man is like a seed; whatsoever you sow, you shall reap. What goes on in your mind is what you live, either you live like a Champion or a Coward. The mind is so powerful that the Bible refers to it as a stronghold.

11Corinthians 10:4-5 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

When you permit unhealthy and immoral thoughts, you find yourself manifesting them because both good and evil behaviour or conduct streams from the heart. For instance, when you think fear, you become afraid; when you think faith, you become stronger; when you think victory, you become a champion, when you think defeat, you become defeated.

Let's take a study of some biblical examples of men who were defined by their thoughts.

PETER

Matthew 14:25-33 But the ship was now in the midst of the sea, tossed with waves: for the wind was contrary. And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea. And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear. But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid. And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water. And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus. But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me. And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?

In the Bible passage above, Peter discovered he could walk on the water and he did so, that is Faith! but the moment he began to concieve some negative thoughts in his heart, fear set in, his focus changed from Jesus to the middle of the sea where he was, immediately he began to sink. Thank God for Jesus! he would have ended his life in the sea.

JOB

Job 3: 25. For the thing which I greatly feared is come upon me, and that which I was afraid of is come unto me.

Before Job was afflicted, he had always nursed the fear of losing his possessions and wealth and his thoughts finally came to reality. You are a product of your thoughts.

LUCIFER

Isaiah 14: 12. How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! 13. For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: 14. I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. 15. Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.

Lucifer also referred to as Satan conceived in his heart to be equal with God, this led to pride and finally led to his doom.

JESUS CHRIST

Philippians 2: 5. Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: 6. Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: 7. But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: 8. And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. 9. Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: 10. That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; 11. And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Jesus Christ our perfect example has a pure and perfect mind and He was humble and obedient unto death therefore he was highly exalted by God. This same mind is what should be found in true Christians.

2 Corinthians 5: 7. (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)

Finally, whatever you picture yourself to be in your heart is what you manifest outwardly. That is why King Solomon said he had seen Princes walking on foot and servants riding on horses. The goodnews is that everything about God's Children has been predetermined and ordained by Him - God's thought towards us is of good and not of evil (Jer 29 : 11) therefore always have good thoughts towards yourself no matter the circumstances around you, let God's Word, Covenant and Promises be your anchor even in the overwhelming flood.

REFLECTION

Proverbs 21:23 (NLT)

Watch your tongue and keep your mouth shut, and you will stay out of trouble.

INTRODUCTION:-

The scripture in Proverbs 21: 23 is absolutely correct because there are countless examples of people, both in the bible and the world around us, who brought destruction upon themselves because they could not tame their tongues

EVENTS AFTER THE RAPTURE

I Thessalonians 4 : 16 – 18 OLUNLOYO FUNMILAYO O

The Rapture as described by the Bible is "the caughting up of the saints of God, the true followers of Christ will be caught up to meet with the Lord in the air. Isaiah 25 : 8, Revelation 21: 4.
