MATTHEW 25 Vs14 - 23

14 For the kingdom of heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods.

15 And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.

16 Then he that had received the five talents went and traded with the same, and made them other five talents.

17 And likewise he that had received two, he also gained other two.

18 But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money.

19 After a long time the lord of those servants cometh, and reckoneth with them.

20 And so he that had received five talents came and brought other five talents, saying, Lord, thou delivered unto me five talents: behold, I have gained beside them five talents more.

21 His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

22 He also that had received two talents came and said, Lord, thou delivered unto me two talents: behold, I have gained two other talents beside them.

23 His lord said unto him, Well done, good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord.

Wisdom tells us we should study examples. Why? Of course, because example is key, it is vital, it's a guide and a pointer to possible eventual occurrence. It is an aid to attempting or solving a given problem.

The Lord always speaks in parables, using different examples to tell us how the kingdom of heaven would be. These scenarios are prophetic in nature, so He expects us to study them carefully and apply them as occasion demands.

In our anchor text, Jesus told us a parable of a man who was travelling to a distant country. He therefore gave all his goods to his servants; to one he gave five, to another two and to another one according to their ability. Two of them traded with their talents and made 100% return each while the third man digged the earth and buried his own talent. Though it took the master awhile to return, but at his return it was a sure 'pay-day' for those servants.

The opening verses of this text almost presented the master of those servants as a Father Christmas who just wanted to share his goods amongst his servants, but calling them for reckoning at his return shows he entrusts the gifts in their care for profit yielding purpose while he is away.

At his return he commended the profitable servants who gave him double fold yield; **"Well done good and faithful servant thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord."**

How does the above parable apply to us?

It tells us the Lord invested in us different levels of grace, gifts and talents based on what we are able to manage and account for at His return. It also shows there is a direct link between the use of our gifts on earth and our position in eternity. Those two faithful servants were rewarded with eternal joy and a promise to make each of them a ruler over many things. **Who we would be and how we would live in eternity is dependent on what we do with God's goods / talents in our care?** We are custodians of divine resources, His talents, gifts and potentials are put in our care to trade with and bring hundred-fold return to God.

Manifesting our gifts matters to God and to the kingdom at large. We are God's Stewards. 1Corin 4: 2 says it is required of a steward to be found faithful. Faithfulness is to keep and multiply the talents, gifts and ministries committed in our care. Someone said the **richest place on earth is the grave**, How? Because it is full of gifts and talents that were never used. - Good business ideas not executed, books never written, Songs neither composed nor sang, messages never preached, Dramas not written or acted, beautiful ministries that never saw the light of the day,

God is not a waster, He is an investor, wherever He puts His best, He expects the best in return.

Is there any penalty for leaving our gifts unused?

We should be finding out in our next edition.

CONCLUSION;

God's dream over that gift in your care is to receive a multiple fold yield at His return. When the Lord comes back like the master of those servants, He's going to ask, **"What did you do about My giftings, My talents and investment in you' ?**

Stay in purpose! Stay Active! Maximize Your Gifts! Don't abort His Dream!! Don't be a waster of Divine Resources!! Your joy and your position in eternity is dependent on it!!!

Bible Text: Isaiah 26:1-8 AMP

1. In that day this song will be sung in the land of Judah: "We have a strong city; He sets up salvation as walls and ramparts.
2. Open the gates, that the righteous nation may enter, the one that remains faithful and trustworthy.
3. You will keep in perfect and constant peace the one whose mind is steadfast [that is, committed and focused on you—in both inclination and character], because he trusts and takes refuge in You [with hope and confident expectation].

No. 6.- Live Busily for Christ.

Jesus gave a parable about this in **Luke 19:13** – **"And he called his ten servants, and delivered them ten pounds, and said unto them, Occupy till I come."**

To "occupy" means to 'be busy'. In this Parable, Jesus tells us that He has given each Christian certain talents, abilities and gifts. Not everyone has the same ones; some of you are more gifted than others. **To those whom He gives more, more is expected!**

The servant who **NEGLECTED** his abilities, was highly **CONDEMNED** by our Lord ... **BECAUSE** ... he was not **BUSY** in the Lord's business.

We **ALL** have our life to live. We **ALL** are **BUSY**. We have got family, work, leisure time, etc. Our plates are full. **BUT**, we need to make time for **Christ AND His Business** OR we will be severely judged when He returns.

God does not like lazy Christians. **"Occupy, till I come."** Make time for Jesus, because if we don't, He will hold us each accountable, when we see Him face-to-face at the Rapture. **DON'T BE "too busy"** doing other things and forgetting your walk with Christ

No. 7.- Live Blamelessly.

The Apostle Paul tells us in **1 Thess. 5:23 (NLT)** – **"Now may the God of peace make you holy in every way, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless until that day when our Lord Jesus Christ comes again."**

"Blameless" speaks of our **REPUTATION**. Everyone here has a **REPUTATION**. You have spent your whole life developing it. It is not something that you have given yourself. **It has been given to you by others** AND it will follow you the rest of your life **UNLESS** you change it!

Your **REPUTATION** will either give glory to God ... OR ... shame His Name.
