Bible Text: Proverbs 29:1 AMP

He who hardens his neck and refuses instruction after being often reprov'd (corrected, criticized), Will suddenly be broken beyond repair.

DISOBEDIENCE OF ONE MAN

Jonah 1:1-3

- 1. Now the word of the Lord came to Jonah the son of Amittai, saying,**
- 2. "Go to Nineveh, that great city, and proclaim [judgment] against it, for their wickedness has come up before Me."**
- 3. But Jonah ran away to Tarshish to escape from the presence of the Lord [and his duty as His prophet]. He went down to Joppa and found a ship going to Tarshish [the most remote of the Phoenician trading cities]. So he paid the fare and went down into the ship to go with them to Tarshish away from the presence of the Lord.**

It's a great thing to be able to hear from God but disobeying Him is disastrous. Jonah was a Prophet called by God. He hears from God.

At a point in time, God called Jonah to go to a great City called Nineveh to warn them against impending danger. Jonah gave in to the lies of the devil on the assignment and started running away from God's presence.

It is absurd for a man to think he can run away from his Creator. It the biggest lie ever! Taking account of the book of Jonah chapter one, the ship Jonah boarded to convey him to Tarshish nearly wrecked in the raging sea.
